In the Freer Gallery of Art visitors will find one of the finest collections of Chinese and Japanese art in the western world. A Detroit industrialist, Charles Lang Freer, was fond of Oriental art. During his trips to London he began collecting it. Later he gave his private collection to the museum which had been opened a century before.

The Renwick gallery shows American art from the 19th to the 21st centuries. The collection has works of modern American artists in glass, ceramics, metal, and wood. The building, begun in 1859, was Washington, D.C.'s first art museum. It is named after the building's architect, James Renwick.

The museum tells about common people who worked in industries, trades and services, looking at their work and pastimes and uses reconstructed scenes, objects and photographs to bring their story to life.

Tapescript

Announcer: Over now to Liz Pearson, who's been finding out about Sydney.

Liz Pearson: When people first explored the area where Sydney stands today, they immediately knew that they were looking at one of the greatest harbours in the world. The best way to see it is to take a ferry from Circular Quay and travel around the harbour, where you'll see all kinds of sailing boats and speedboats. The view is dominated by two sights: the Sydney Harbour Bridge and the Sydney Opera House. The bridge joins North Sydney, on one side of the harbour, to central Sydney and was completed in 1932. It's used by cars, trains, cycles, and even people on foot, which is probably the way to get the best view from the bridge. You won't see much from a car.

The Opera House is one of the most famous buildings in the world and some people say that its design is based on the shape of a sailing boat. As well as opera, you can visit the Opera House to see ballet, films and classical music concerts. It's very popular, and it's not always easy to get tickets for some performances. You might also find that it's a little expensive, although those under twenty-seven can get special reduced prices.

Just a little further along from the Opera House you'll find the Royal Botanical Gardens. This is rather like a large park, with collections of flowers, trees and other plants from all over Australia. Here, you can also see the flying foxes, a kind of bat.

Away from the waterfront, Sydney has plenty to entertain the visitor. Because there are so many people from different cultures in Sydney, there is a lot of choice when it comes to eating out. There are a number of excellent restaurants serving Thai food, including Tuk Tuk in Bayswater Road, and places to eat traditional and modern Australian cuisine, like the famous Bill's.

A round-up of the attractions of Sydney wouldn't be complete without mentioning the beaches. To the south of the city is Bondi Beach, a name that everybody has heard of. Here, Sydneysiders, as residents of Sydney are called, come to play. It's a well-developed beach, but like many places in Australia the sea can be dangerous, although there's no need to worry as the beach is patrolled by lifeguards, who make sure nobody gets themselves into trouble.

Finally, make sure you visit Taronga Zoo, on the north side of harbour. You can get there by ferry from central Sydney. As well as the great collection of animals from around the world, you'll get a great view of the harbour from here. A picnic

looking down on the boats and ferries travelling on the water can be a great way to spend the afternoon.

Location	Meals	Language	Month
At the seaside (the Black sea)	Breakfast	English and Russian as young people from all parts of the world come to practice Russian	July
By lake Baikal	Three meals a day	English	May
In the mountains (the Altai)	You have to cook meals yourself	English	July

NOTE: When the student asks you about the camp location, tell her/him **only about the first two**. After she/he elicited all the information about them, tell her/him that there is one more camp.

- **courses to practise English**, tell her/him: “Courses are not available. You can practise English socializing with people from different countries.”
